

New Modular Storage System to be Introduced at SEMA

LAS VEGAS, NV - While most of the new products introduced at SEMA in 2004 are designed to go on your car, one is designed to go next to it. Metal Line Cabinet Systems of Anaheim, CA, introduced a new line of heavy-duty, all steel storage cabinets that are sure to make your garage the envy of the block. The system features a unique, patent pending, internal frame which makes the cabinets extremely strong, and a refined, powder coated exterior that matches the look and durability of a mechanic's toolbox.

The key to the system's modular design is the "H-panel," an internal frame constructed from 1 1/2" square steel tubing that provides the foundation for all of the other components. The adjustable shelves are supported by the frame, giving each shelf a rated capacity of 300 lbs. The doors and finished end-panels are formed from 18 ga. steel, and can be powder coated in virtually any color to match your decor. The system features wall-mounted, bench, corner and floor cabinets, as well as a versatile drawer cabinet that can be outfitted with a variety of different drawer sizes. With widths ranging from 12 to 48," that system can be made to fit most spaces to within six inches. A variety of stainless steel, as well as maple butcher block tops complete the unit.

Besides the strength and flexibility of the modular design, the Metal Line system has a few other interesting features and benefits. Because the cabinets don't rely on the outer panels for strength, adjoining cabinets are open to one another on the inside, allowing objects too long to be stored in one cabinet to be passed-through several. All of the cabinet doors feature full-length pulls that are formed from the same sheet of steel as the door, and so can never come loose or fall off. The doors are hung from self-closing hinges that eliminate the need for mechanical catches or magnets, and they close against a unique hydraulic decelerator - a small, fluid-filled cylinder that gently eases the door shut against the frame regardless of how hard it is slammed.

If you are searching for the best in storage for your garage or shop, you should definitely give Metal Line a look. The cabinets have an unusually high level of fit and finish for products in this category, and seem to be designed to last as long as the structure into which they are installed.
